New Air France Buses Offer Efficient Express Shuttle Service From Charles-De-Gaulle Airport To Paris

Car, taxi, subway or bus? Most travelers flying to a large city airport are faced with the dilemma of transfers. New, state-of-the-art, spacious, air-conditioned buses - all equipped with a GDS satellite navigation system to help avoid traffic - with courteous experienced drivers and baggage handlers provide passengers from all airlines a pleasant, hassle-free transfer. With only 51 seats, there is plenty of leg room. At the airport, efficient signage guides passengers to the sheltered bus stops, conveniently located right outside the terminals.

Daily non-stop service, from 5:45 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., is available from all CDG Airport terminals - Hall 2B, gate B6; Hall 2D, gate D6 and Hall 2F, arrival gate F - to four convenient locations in Paris, close to metro stops, taxi stations and the main rail stations. Service from Paris to CDG Airport is available from the same locations with the same frequency:

- Porte Maillot - every 15 minutes, from 5:45 am to 11:30 pm
- Place de l'Etoile - every 15 minutes, from 5:45 am to 11:30 pm
- Gare de Lyon - every 30 minutes, from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm
- Gare Montparnasse - every 30 minutes, from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm

Price of a round-trip ticket to any of the four above locations: \$25.00.

Children 2 to 11 years old are entitled to a 50% discount on each one-way fare.

Air France Buses are also available for local or long distance charter and tour groups.
