Daily non-stop service, from 5:45 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., is available from all CDG Airport terminals: 2B, gate B6; Hall 2D, gate D6 and Hall 2F, arrival gate F - to four convenient locations in Paris, including bus stops, taxi stations and the main rail stations. Service from Paris to CDG Airport is available from the same locations with the same frequency:

- Porte Maillot - every 15 minutes, from 5:45 am to 11:30 pm
- Place de l'Etoile - every 15 minutes, from 5:45 am to 11:30 pm
- Gare de Lyon - every 30 minutes, from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm
- Gare Montparnasse - every 30 minutes, from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm

Price of a round-trip ticket to any of the four above locations: \$25.00.

Children 2 to 11 years old are entitled to a 50% discount on each one-way fare.

Air France Buses are also available for local or long distance charter and tour groups.
